### Our unit will dive into...

- \* How communities can work together to create change. \*Businesses that produce goods and services
- \*How roles of people within an organization impact society

### We will explore these key concepts:

- \* **Causation**— Why is it like it is? \***Function**- How does it work? \***Connection**- How is it connected to other things?

### Our guiding questions will include:

- \* What do communities do to help each other during a time of need? \*How do communities re-build after natural disasters? \*How would a natural disaster make you feel?
