An inquiry into human relationships including families, friends, communities, and cultures; rights and responsibilities; what it means to be human.

This IB unit takes a look at tolerance and accepting those different from us.

Central Idea: Learners can develop an awareness of differences among people in the world.

Our unit will dive into...

* Showing respect for individual differences (Responsibility) *How we use our senses to learn about the world (Function) *Understanding how people with disabilities live (Perspective)

We will explore these key concepts:

* **Responsibility** – What is our responsibility? ***Function**- How does it work? ***Perspective**- What are the points of view?

Our guiding questions will include:

* How can you show respect to others with differences? *How are we the same and different?
*How do we use our senses in everyday life? *How can we use other senses when we are lacking in a sense?

We will focus on being these Learner Profile attributes:

* **Caring**-We are kind. ***Thinker**- We think about things in the world.
