

2nd Grade Spotlight:

Sharing the Planet

An inquiry into rights and responsibilities in the struggle to share finite resources with other people and with other living things; communities and the relationships within and between them; access to equal opportunities.

This IB unit takes a look at survival, relationships, and resources.

Central Idea: Relationships and opportunities can influence survival.



Our unit will dive into...

* All living things share resources for survival (connection) *Survival is based upon available resources (opportunity) (change) *Reflecting on opportunities to improve limited resources (reflection)

We will explore these key concepts:

* **Connection**-How is it connected to other things? **Change**-How is it changing? **Reflection**- How do we know?

Our guiding questions will include:

* Why do people want to be treated equally? *How do people overcome things they cannot control?
*Why are relationships important? *What resources are needed for survival?

We will focus on being these Learner Profile attributes:

***Communicators**-We share ideas. **Reflective**-We think about how to be better.

We will demonstrate these IB Attitudes:

***Commitment**-We are dedicated. **Cooperation**- We work with others.

We will practice these skills:

* **Communication skills**- listening, speaking, presenting, **Social Skills**- accepting responsibility, respecting others, cooperating, decision making,
