This IB unit takes a look at citizenship and choices.

Central Idea: *Citizenship and choices made can transform character.*

Our unit will dive into...

- * Rights and responsibilities of citizens. (Responsibility) *Consequences of choices. (Reflection)
- *How our choices can change our character. (Connection)

We will explore these key concepts:

- * **Responsibility**- What is our responsibility? * **Reflection**—How do we know? ***Connection**- How is it connected to other things?

Our guiding questions will include:

- *What does it mean to be a good citizen? *How are things connected? *How does everything inside the body work?

We will focus on being these Learner Profile attributes:

- * **Caring**-We are kind. ***Principled**-.We tell the truth. **Knowledgeable**-We know about a lot of things.

We will demonstrate these IB Attitudes:

- ***Enthusiasm**-We enjoy learning. ***Integrity**-We are honest.

- * **Thinking Skills**- We will acquire knowledge about ourselves and others. ***Social Skills**- We will discover how to resolve conflicts, cooperate, and respect each other. ***Communication Skills**- We will listen, speak, read, and present findings.
