

# 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade Spotlight:

An inquiry into rights and responsibilities in the struggle to share finite resources with other people and with other living things

*This IB unit takes a look at Earth's resources and survival.*

**Central Idea: The survival of living things can be impacted by Earth's resources.**

### Our unit will dive into...

\* Natural resources. (Form) \*How living things survive. (Function) \*How our actions impact Earth's resources. (Responsibility)

### We will explore these key concepts:

\***Form**- What is it like? \***Function**-How does it work? \***Responsibility**-What is our responsibility?

### Our guiding questions will include:

\* If you could live in another part of North America, where would it be and why? \*How does where you live affect your behavior? \*How has Brigham Academy impacted your life experiences?
