An inquiry into the ways in which we discover and express ideas, feelings, nature, culture, beliefs and values

This IB unit takes a close look into celebrations around the world!

Central Idea: *Societies participate in different traditions and celebrations.*

Our unit will dive into...

- * What holidays and traditions are like around the world * How families celebrate holidays differently.
- * How holidays and traditions are organized and celebrated.

We will explore these key concepts:

- * **Causation**- Why is it like it is? **Perspective**-What are the points of view? **Form**-What is it like?

Our guiding questions will include:

- * What is a tradition/holiday? * Why do people celebrate different things? How do you celebrate holidays at your house? Is one holiday/tradition better than another?

We will focus on being these Learner Profile attributes:

- * **Knowledgeable**- We know about a lot of things. **Communicators**- We share ideas. **Open-Minded**- We consider other points of view.

We will demonstrate these IB Attitudes:

- * **Creativity**- We use our imagination. **Curiosity**- We show an interest in learning about the world around us. **Tolerance**- We are accepting of others.

- * **Communication Skills**- We will listen, speak, and work collaboratively. **Research Skills**- We will research other cultures
