**Central Idea: *Organizations serve a purpose in the community.***

### **Our unit will dive into...**

\*Community helpers, their roles, and interconnectedness (form) \*Discovering how people can serve a purpose for their community. (function) \* The characteristics and job responsibilities of various community helpers. (responsibility)

### **We will explore these key concepts:**

\*Form- What is it like? \*Function-How does it work? \*Responsibility-What is our responsibility?

### **Our guiding questions will include:**

\*What would happen if we didn't have laws? \*What would happen if a community was missing specific jobs? \*How do people decide what job they are going to do? \* What are the attributes and duties of a responsible citizen?
