



Kindergarten Spotlight:

Sharing the Planet



An inquiry into rights and responsibilities in the struggle to share finite resources with other people and with other living things;

This IB unit takes a close look into habitat changes.

Central Idea: Living things are transformed by changes to habitats.

Our unit will dive into...

- * How all habitats are connected in the world. (connection) *How habitats can change over time. (change) *Our responsibility for finite resources and the environment. (responsibility)

We will explore these key concepts:

* **Connection**- How is it connected to other things? **Responsibility**-What is our responsibility? **Change**-How is it changing?

Our guiding questions will include:

- * Why do we need to do to take care of our Earth? *Why do we need to protect finite resources?
- *How can we protect living things and their environments?

We will focus on being these Learner Profile attributes:

***Caring**- We are kind. **Reflective**-We think about how to be better. **Inquirer**-We ask questions and are curious.

We will demonstrate these IB Attitudes:

***Curiosity**-We show an interest in learning about the world around us. **Appreciation**- We are thankful. **Commitment**- We are dedicated.

***Research Skills**- We will form questions, observe, record data, plan, and organize data
