Device Opt-Out 2022-2023

Through the Digital Learning Initiative, Polk County Schools is a 1:1 school district in which all students have a digital device to support their learning goals. Polk County students have the option to receive an iPad or computer, depending on the school they attend, to use in class and at home at no cost.

Devices available in Polk County Public Schools

Elementary school students will receive iPads:

- iPad
- Keyboard Case
- Charger
- Protective sleeve

Secondary schools (6-8; 9-12; 6-12) students will receive either laptops or iPads based on the school's choice of device:

- Laptop/iPad and keyboard case
- Charger
- Protective sleeve

Parents/guardians may opt out their child from taking a Polk County Schools digital device home if a comparable personal device is available for the student to use at home.

Rights and responsibilities:

Students who have opted out of taking home a PCPS device must still have access to all learning materials.

By signing below, you acknowledge the following:

- A device will be provided to my child while at school, but will not be taken home.
- Students will use district issued email and applications (access through Classlink).
- I will ensure my child arrives early to school each day to pick up their assigned device in a school designated area, be in class before the bell rings and return the device before going home.
