2022-2023 Digital Learning Initiative

Through the Digital Learning Initiative, Polk County is now a 1:1 school district in which all students have a digital device to support their learning goals. Polk County elementary students have the option to receive an iPad, to use in class and at home at no cost to families.

Student devices are considered an instructional material such as a textbook, calculator, etc. Students are expected to follow the Code of Conduct and Responsible Use Policy.

Devices will begin going home no later than October 13th.

Your child will receive the following:

- iPad ● Keyboard Case ● Protective Sleeve

Students are expected to return district-issued mobile devices and device peripherals in the same condition in which they were issued. While normal wear and tear will be taken into consideration, students who have mistreated the equipment will be responsible for repair or replacement costs. In this event, students will be issued a financial obligation to cover the cost of repairing or replacing the equipment (PCPS Device Repair and Recovery Costs 2022-2023).

The Device Recovery Costs chart below provides a list of the most common repair costs for the different mobile devices used in Polk County Public Schools as part of the Digital Learning Initiative. It is not a comprehensive list, and any other damage not included in the list below will be assessed and assigned a fee according to the damage.

Parents/guardians may opt out their child from taking a Polk County Schools digital device home if a comparable personal device is available for the student to use at home. Rights and Responsibilities: Students who have opted out of taking home a PCPS device must still have access to all learning materials.

All students will receive a device. For Families that opt-out of a device going home you will need to submit a **“Device Opt-Out Form 2022-2023”**. Copies of this form can be found in the front office or with your child’s teacher.
